Type the code shown: Unlike benzodiazepines, where onset of action and time to maximum benefit are short, patients must take buspirone for three to four weeks before feeling the maximum benefit of the drug. They should also be observed for symptoms of benzodiazepine withdrawal. Buspirone also acts through a different mechanism than barbiturates such as phenobarbital.
